




Use Label Everything



1. Double click on the Label Tool, the Label Defaults Settings appear

2. Set per tool your favourite settings




3. Use 'Text Style' for setting font type and size

4. Use 'Symbol Label' for setting information display

5. User Interface with extra explanation and options

5. Closing the Label Defaults Settings to save your settings



6. Select your elements

7. Go to Listing and Labeling and check 'Label'


Using the 'ANY parameter'-option

(ANY parameter only works with Window, Door, Object and Lamp.)

1. Select the 'ANY parameter'-option

-With method 'Automatic (shows all available information)' the ANY parameter is displayed automatically.


-With method 'Select element (shows one item of information)' you need to select the element type first with CHOOSE ELEMENT TYPE.



2. Select the object you want information from

3. Select File/Libraries and Objects/Open Object

4. Search in the objects Parameters for the right parameter and note the Variable



5. Type this exactly behind 'Any parameter from object'

Examples:

Door: Leaf width

Beam (name complex profile)
Object (parameter 'profile')
