

← PERFECT. ARROW IN CENTER OF FIRST WORD. NO PROBLEM.

← NO GOOD. I WANT ARROW VERTICALLY CENTERED ON FIRST LETTER OF FIRST WORD.

MUCH WORSE. ARROW SHOULD NOW BE CENTERED ON LAST LETTER OF LAST WORD AND SHOULD **DEFINITELY** START HORIZONTALLY CLOSER TO THE TEXT IN ANY CASE. →

← ALSO A BUMMER: IF I WANT MULTIPLE ARROWS FROM THE SAME LABEL, I HAVE TO CREATE THEM MANUALLY OR COPY AND MODIFY THE LABEL. AT LEAST IF I DO THIS, I CAN PUT THE COPIES WHERE I WANT THEM, (ASSUMING I'M OKAY WITH THE INCONSISTENCY, WHICH I'M NOT) BUT THEN IF THE TEXT CHANGES, THEY DON'T AUTO-UPDATE... :( →

← ( I TYPICALLY HANDLE THE ABOVE SITUATION LIKE THIS INSTEAD, PLACING THE RIGHT ARROW WHERE IT WOULD GO BY DEFAULT. I JUST GRUMBLE WHEN I DO IT. AT LEAST I CAN GET THE RIGHT ARROW CLOSER TO THE TEXT THAN IT WOULD DEFAULT.) →

← THIS IS WHAT I WOULD HAVE IT LOOK LIKE IF I COULD, WHEN I NEED A MULTIPLE LINE AND / OR MULTIPLE ARROW. UNFORTUNATELY, I HAD TO CREATE THIS WITH AN INDEPENDENT TEXT BLOCK AND THREE ARROWS →
